- Have an EHCP plan
- Have an allocated social worker
- Or have a parent who is defined as a key worker

In light of the school closure we will be providing home learning for all children via the school website. This can be found under the 'children' tab in 'homework'. Homework will start on Monday 23rd March and will be set daily. Updates will also be emailed or sent via text.

Thank you for all your patience and co-operation during this difficult time. The lovely emails, acts of kindness, cakes and messages are very much appreciated by the staff. We have raised £153 today, for our local food bank, who will be extremely grateful for this generous donation.

It is very sad to think that this could be the last day in our school for some children. We will ensure that once this situation has eased, a true celebration in some form or other will be held for our leavers.
