Dear parents/carers,

As you may be aware guidance for schools was issued on Thursday 2nd July and we are formulating a 'safe return to school plan' for all pupils. This will include staggered start and pick up times and continued use of our one-way system (please watch the video in the Covid section on our website). Once plans are confirmed we will share this information with you.

We are now busy preparing our rooms, resources and curriculum for a full return in September. We are all keen to hit the ground running both safely and in line with government guidance. Unless we return to some kind of lockdown we will welcome you ALL back in September. You will receive a 'class information sheet' from your child's class teacher.
