End of year reports

All reports will be emailed to you from 3.30pm onwards on Monday 6th July.

Price changes from September 2020

School lunches will be £2.40 per child an increase from £2.30. (unless your child is entitled to free school meals or is entitled to universal free school meals).

Tiger Club morning session will be £5.50 per child. Pick up 3.15pm-4.30pm will be £3.50 per child, pick up between 4.30pm-6.00pm will be £7.50 per child. A child attending both session is £11. Before 4.30pm only snack & a drink will be served. After 4.30pm a light tea will be served.

Extended Nursery If you wish for your child to stay for the afternoon and they aren't entitled to the 30 hours funding the charge will be £12.12 per child.

Social Distancing

Polite reminder - please ensure only one adult brings and collects pupils to school and keeps their distance, both in the queues and whilst navigating the one way system.
