To help keep everyone safe and help with social distancing please can children refrain from riding their scooters up and down the paths. Please walk with the scooter until off the school grounds.

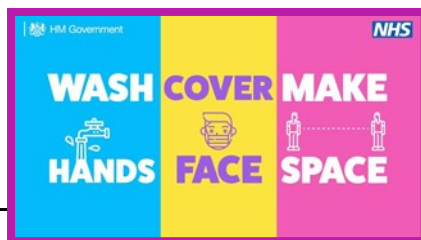

<p>Someone in my household has symptoms of coronavirus</p>	<p>Do not come into school. The person who is unwell must get a test. Inform school of the result and keep in contact with school each day</p>	<p>Only return to school if the test comes back negative. <i>For a positive test, see below.</i></p>
<p>Someone in my household has had a positive coronavirus test</p>	<p>Do not come into school. Self-isolate for 14 days Contact school each day</p>	<p>After 14 days</p>
<p>NHS track and trace identify my child as being in contact with someone with coronavirus</p>	<p>Do not come into school Self-isolate for 14 days Contact school each day</p>	<p>After 14 days</p>
