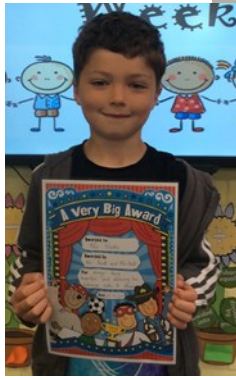
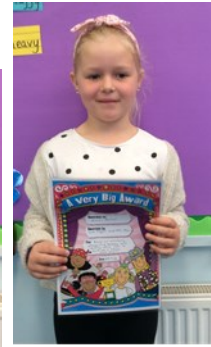


Academy Photographs—16th October
