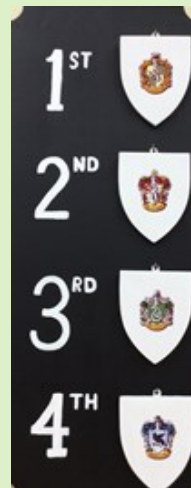

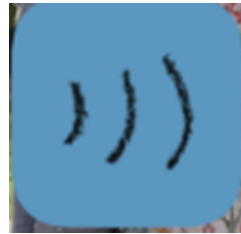

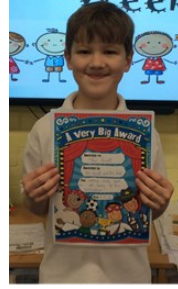


Christmas lunch—Thursday 17th December.

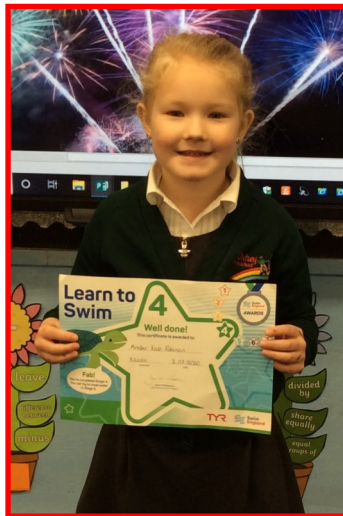
