Dear parents and carers,

We are really looking forward to welcoming all the children back on Monday. I would like to take this opportunity to summarise a few reminders to keep us all safe:



- We have our one-way system in place at drop off and pick-up times. This one-way system is to avoid direct contact with each other and to support social distancing. Please keep your child(ren) with you at all times and do not let them run off ahead.
- When waiting to drop off and collect your child please wait on the spots adhering to social distancing guidance
- Unless you are exempt, please wear a mask at all times when on site.
- Leave the school site promptly after drop off and collection
- Keep other siblings by your side when waiting for your child
- Please do not allow your children onto the wooden furniture or playground equipment

Your child only needs a water bottle and plastic wallet for their planner & reading book. They can come to school in their PE kit on their PE day (EYFS & KS1 on Thurs. KS2 on Wed)

- Help to reduce waiting times by dropping off and collecting at allocated times and not arriving early (see table below)

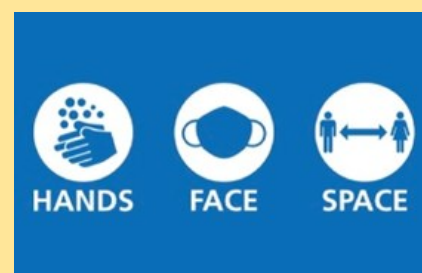

Reception have read 'Sugarlump & the Unicorn'

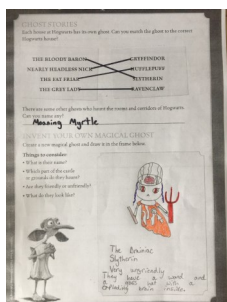
KS1 have explored 'Alice in Wonderland'

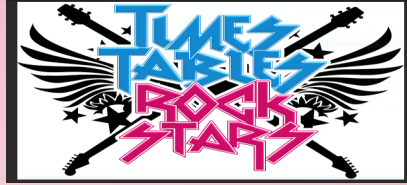
