Have a great weekend, enjoy the match (it's coming home) stay safe and take care from Mrs Jukes and the Oxhey Team.

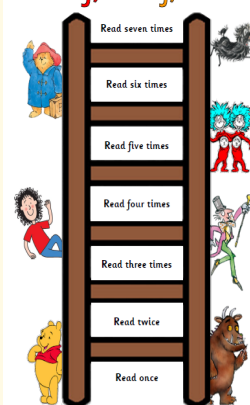

## If you have been in close contact with someone who tests positive

- 1 You may be alerted by NHS Test and Trace**

  - You complete 10 day isolation
- positive for COVID-19

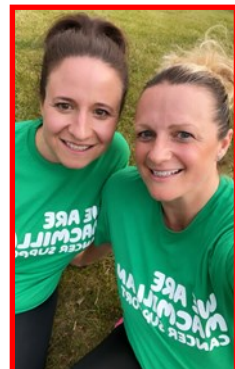
