Dear Parents/Guardians,

We are pleased to inform you that your child will take part in Forest School sessions on **Monday afternoons**. Please can your child come dressed in their Forest school clothes on the days of their sessions. Children may come in trainers but ensure that they bring wellington boots/walking boots with them to change into. The sessions will be led by a trained Forest School leader. By taking the children outside it encourages them to learn social, physical and educational skills whilst appreciating and understanding the woodland environment through a wide variety of activities and tasks geared for them. Activities include observing nature, making natural artwork, building shelters and using tools to make items with (for example, cooking on a fire). The sessions are fun and give the children a chance to learn in a safe environment. Due to the very changeable weather, it is impossible to say if it will be raining, snowing or sunny so please watch the weather forecast and then dress your child appropriately.
