I hope that you have had a lovely week - I cannot believe we only have two weeks left this term!

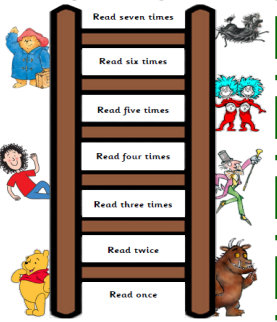

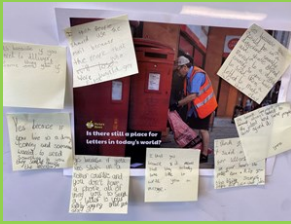
There will be small prizes for the best creations. In particular we are looking for children's own work and ideas.

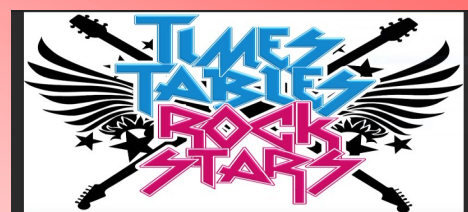

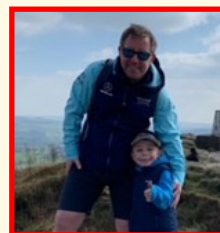
