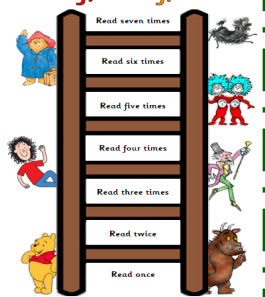
Dear parents and carers,

Ready, Steady, READ! - Results

The results are based on the number of children who have read four or more times in the week.

Well done to everyone who read and took part in the challenge last week.

As I am sure that you are aware, the government has now changed the rules around testing for Covid-19 as the country has moved into a 'living with Covid' phase. Children no longer need to test weekly but are strongly advised to take a test if they display symptoms.

Event	Actions
If you have respiratory infection symptoms or symptoms of Covid.	Take a Covid test if available. If it is positive, please follow the advice for a positive test result (see below). The advice is to isolate and remain at home for 3 days (if 18 or under) to minimise the risk of infecting others. Please inform the school immediately of any absence.
POSITIVE Covid-19 TEST	Isolate immediately and remain at home for three days. On the fourth day, children (18 and under) can return to school. For example, if your child tests positive on Monday morning, they can return to school on Thursday. Adults are 'strongly' advised to isolate and remain at home for 5 days.
There is Covid-19 in the home.	Children can come into school unless they develop symptoms. If they do, they should follow the advice above.
For any vomiting or diarrhoea bug, we would ask that your child remains at home for 48 hours following the last bout.	

Children are safe to return after **Day 3, even if the test is still POSITIVE**. However, if they still have a temperature, vomiting or diarrhoea or feel very unwell, **you must remain at home** and seek advice from NHS 111.

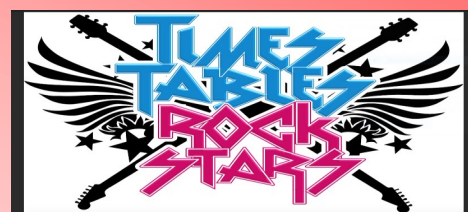
