I have lots of 'well done's' to share this week:

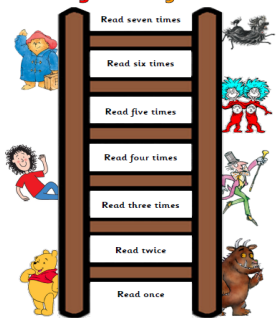
- In the Early Years the children have been finding out about the life cycle of a frog and their drawings, model making and writing is amazing.

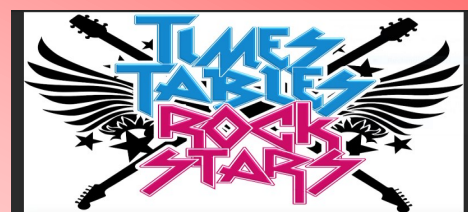

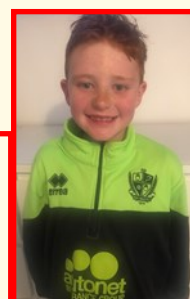
