Create a PowerPoint of how school has changed over the last 150 years. Look at what school was like for children in the Victorian Times. And compare this to school in your parents' lives and your own. For example: Did you parent have IPADS? Did your parents have whiteboards?	Create own renewable home. What material would it be made out of? How would it blend in and look natural? How would you let light in? Would it be solar-powered? Children can draw and label their design. Challenge: What could go wrong with your design?	Create a piece of art homework using natural materials. This links to the idea of renewable products. It could be a collage using yoghurt pots or even objects from the garden. You could create a natural scene such as one at the beach or the forest.

Y4: Please learn the songs for the end of year production which we will be giving out this term. Y3 : Learn the National Anthem or a classic British song by a British band...Queen are a fabulous example!	Y3: Investigate the three different types of rock: igneous, sedimentary and metamorphic. What types of rock are in each group and where can they be found? Y4: Sound—Could you design an instrument using household items. Can you make it louder? Can you investigate the different sounds that it could create?	As we have been using the software SCRATCH, spend time using this to create your own SPRITE. SCRATCH JR is downloadable as a free app, so this would be a great app to get your children familiar with.
