100% To 96%	Child has had up to 7 days 14 sessions of absence from school.	Attendance is good to excellent
95% To 93%	Child has had up to 13 days 26 sessions of absence from school.	Attendance beginning to cause a concern. Parents could receive a letter advising of our concern. Medical evidence will need to be provided for further absences
92% To 90%	Child has had up to 19 days 38 sessions of absence school.	Attendance is a more significant concern. Parents will be invited to a meeting to discuss concerns. A plan to support absence will be implemented and regularly reviewed.
90% To 85% & below	Child has had up to 29 days 58 sessions of absence from school.	Attendance is a major concern. If absence is unauthorised, a referral may be made to the Local Authority for Statutory Action.
