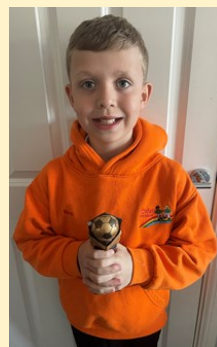
In the spotlight this week

Netball Festival

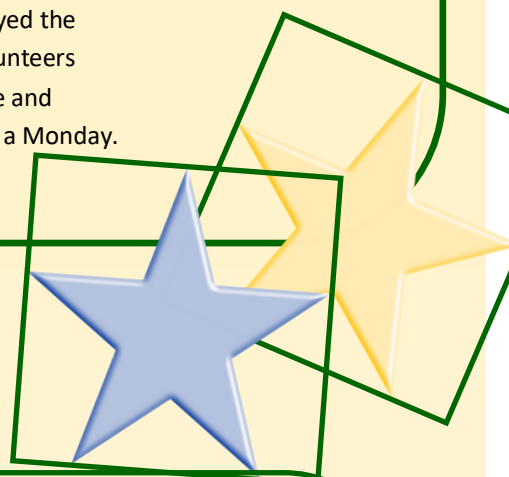
