

#### **Sleeping Arrangements**

- Girls and Boys are in separate dormitories.
- All dorms have bunk beds so please let us know if your child is a sleep walker/needs to be the bottom bunk.
- ► Toilets and bathrooms are on each floor and children are able to use these in the night if needed (night lights are in the corridors so children can see)
- The school staff are placed in individual rooms next to the dormitories (but within the same building). Teachers are accessible during the night if required.



### Meals, Money and Snacks

- You are asked to provide a packed lunch for the first day only. Then all other meals are provided during the stay.
- You can also send a snack for the Wednesday and Thursday night (e.g. a packet of crisps/chocolate bar) but it must not contain nuts due to allergies with children form our own and other schools.

#### **Timings**
