## Eco Shine Week

This week, all children have taken part in some fantastic activities which will help to promote our Eco status and develop the school grounds.

The children in KS1 worked in small teams to build a hedgehog house and these will be dug in around the school grounds to encourage the hedgehogs to nest there.











In KS2, the children were very busy scattering wildflower seeds, planting bulbs in to the tyres

and plant pots and making bird feeders which will be spread around the school grounds. We are developing a wildlife area in the far corner of the field, so the new trees and saplings we had from the Woodland Trust were dug up and relocated to create a hedgerow.





The children in Early Years were busy making bird feeders and growing cress for their Trolls (linked to The Three Billy Goats Gruff). They also had a range of activities linked to the changing seasons and

weather, as well as drawing daffodils and

learning about different habitats for animals!

What a busy week we've all had.
